2024 Stonewall Columbus Pride Vendor Frequently Asked Questions

What are the dates and locations for the 2024 Stonewall Columbus Pride Festival?

The festival is located at Goodale Park

Friday, June 14th 4:00pm - 10:00 pm

Saturday, June 15th 11:00am - 8:00pm

When can vendors apply for 2024 Pride?

The vendor applications will be live March 1 <u>here</u> and applications must be submitted by April 19th. No late applications will be accepted.

Does a vendor space come with a tent, chairs, or tables?

No, a tent can be purchased through Stonewall and will be set up and ready on the day of Pride. The tents do not come with walls. We do <u>not</u> rent or provide tables or chairs, please bring your own. The sizes and corresponding prices for each space will be listed within your Eventeny application and on the <u>Stonewall Columbus website</u>.

What parking is available to vendors?

Due to the size and location of our festival Stonewall Columbus is no longer able to provide any vendor-specific parking day-of the festival. Please visit our Get Here, Stay Here page at https://stonewallcolumbus.org/gethere/ to see available parking near the festival.

How does parking work for setting up?

Vendors will be allowed to drive their vehicles in to unload along the roads of Goodale Park. Vehicles parked more than 30 minutes will be asked to move their car out to allow other vendors space to unload. All vehicles unloading must exit the park by 2:30pm on Friday and 10:30am on Saturday. No vehicles will be permitted to drive on any of the paths within the park, only the paved roads. We encourage you to bring a wagon or dolly to transport your items to your space.

What times are set up and tear down?

Food vendors will set up on Thursday evening from 6:30pm - 8:30pm. Non-food vendors will set up Friday from 10:00am - 2:00pm and Saturday 8:00am - 10:00am. All vendors can start bringing their vehicles in to tear down AFTER all festival guests have left the park on Saturday. All vehicles must be out of the park by 10:30pm.

Are we allowed to hand out water?

Water is permitted to be given out for free. No soda, energy drinks, or sports drinks are permitted to be given out or sold by any vendors. Vendors found in violation of this will be excluded from participating in any future Stonewall Columbus Pride events.

When will I know if I have been approved as a vendor?

Vendors must submit their applications by April 19th. If approved as a vendor, you must confirm those application details and secure your registration details by May 3rd. Vendors will be charged upon approval. If waitlisted, you will be notified by May 10th if you have been released from the waitlist and are able to register as a vendor.

If approved, what do I get as part of my vendor space registration?

You will be provided with a space to set up your booth. Tents are available for an additional cost and will be set up prior to your arrival. Tables and chairs are NOT included in your registration and will not be provided. Walls on tents are not included in the tent fee and will not be provided.

What are the available space sizes?

We have 10x10, 10x20 and 10x30 vendor spaces available. If you need additional space, you will need to purchase two spaces.

Where is power provided for vendors?

Electric will be available within 150' behind your spot. Electric is \$75 for basic and \$175 for premium. You will need to bring your own extension cords; Stonewall Columbus does not provide any extension cords.

When/Where is check-in?

Vendor check-in is located on Park St with the entrance located on the corner of Buttles Ave and Park St.

Check in for food vendors ONLY is Thursday evening from 6:30pm - 8:30pm.

Check in for <u>non-food vendors ONLY</u> will be Friday from 10:00am - 2:00pm and Saturday 8:00am - 10:00am. Vehicles need to be removed from the park by 10:30am.

When will I know my vendor placement within the festival?

Vendors will find out their park placement at check-in. Due to permitting and last minute scheduling conflicts that may arise we are not able to provide you with your space location in advance.

How do I get a spot along the road?

All the spots within the park are along an accessible path but those with mobility or accessibility needs can let us know within their application and we can make those accommodations.
